

Equity markets strengthened in September despite an evolving macro backdrop. The U.S. economy continued to show resilience, with moderating inflation and easing Treasury yields supporting valuations. Renewed optimism around global growth, along with a rebound in cyclical and smaller-cap sectors, further lifted sentiment.

At its September 16-17 meeting, the Federal Reserve cut rates for the first time this year, lowering the federal funds rate by a quarter point to a target range of 4.00%-4.25%. The move reflected softer labor data and rising downside risks to growth. Policymakers signaled that additional cuts remain possible depending on inflation and employment trends. For equities, the decision reinforced expectations of a more supportive policy stance, providing a tailwind for growth-oriented sectors.

Artificial intelligence remained a major driver of market enthusiasm as enterprises and governments accelerated adoption across workflows, supply chains, and infrastructure. During the most recent quarterly earnings report, several companies underscored surging demand for cloud capacity, with management citing AI-driven compute needs and issuing guidance ahead of expectations. AI is rapidly shifting from experimentation to scaled deployment, already delivering efficiency gains that enhance productivity and competitiveness. We see this as a powerful long-term catalyst for the Edgewood portfolio and the broader economy, even as it raises new questions around labor participation.

We remain focused on a concentrated portfolio of what we deem to be, high-quality, well-managed businesses with durable competitive advantages. These companies have generally navigated complex environments while delivering value. We are confident in their ability to sustain growth and innovation over time, and we thank you for your continued trust and partnership.
